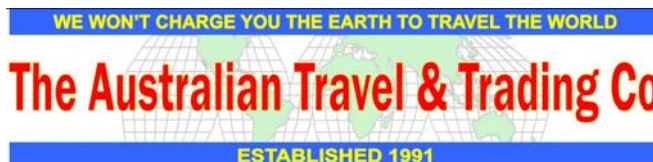

Day 1: Saturday 05 March 2011

We all meet at Sydney airport and depart at 1640 on our Norfolk Air flight to Norfolk Island. We arrive there at 2045 and after clearing customs we are transferred to our accommodation. A light supper will be served tonight at our hotel.

We will be staying at the Hillcrest Hotel for 7 nights.

The hotel features a restaurant, bar and a swimming pool. The hotel is within easy walking distance to the shops at Burnt Pine.

Day 2: Sunday 06 March 2011

Foundation Day Picnic

After breakfast we go to Kingston to see a re-enactment of the first landing of convicts on Norfolk Island. A special Commandants Foundation Day picnic lunch is included today. A light supper will be served at our hotel tonight.

Day 3: Monday 07 March 2011

Half day tour & Wonderland by Night

Full buffet breakfast at our hotel.

Today we set off on our orientation tour of the island. See the convict buildings, visit the Melanesian Chapel.

A delicious morning tea (included) will be served in the garden of an historic island home built by Fletcher Quintal a descendant of the 'Bounty' mutineers.

Own arrangements for lunch with the rest of the afternoon at leisure.

Tonight, after our 2 course dinner at our hotel, we are taken to 'Wonderland by Night'. The setting is 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines and bushland lit up like an enchanting forest. Archie, a descendant of the 'Bounty' mutineers, will recite his poems as we stroll through the forest.

Day 4: Tuesday 08 March 2011

Convict Settlement tour

Mutiny on the Bounty show

Full buffet breakfast at our hotel.

There is time to relax this morning or go shopping. Own arrangements for lunch. We have a full afternoon and evening planned, starting with our Convict Settlement tour. On this in-depth tour we will hear the history of the early convicts, see the restored houses on Quality Row and learn about the infamous Crank Mill. Our Island Fish Fry dinner is at Puppies Point on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline. It's a real feast – fresh fried fish, island salads, desserts and tea or coffee! We end today's activities at the Mutiny on the Bounty Show. See descendants of the mutineers bring the story of the famed "mutiny on the Bounty" to life in a 1.5 hour show performed in an outdoor amphitheatre.



**Day 5: Wednesday 09 March 2011
Island Culture Tour
Progressive Dinner**

Full buffet breakfast at our hotel. We have a free morning to stroll into town to browse in the shops. Own arrangements for lunch. This afternoon we set off on our Island Culture tour. From the mutineers and their Tahitian wives come the crafts of wood carving, weaving, cooking and the Norfolk language. Afternoon tea is included. Another highlight is our Progressive Dinner! It's a fun night out and a great way to meet the local people as we visit local homes to sample some of the wonderful island food.

**Day 6: Thursday 10 March 2011
Barney Duffys
Sound and Light Show**

Full buffet breakfast at our hotel. Morning at leisure and own arrangements for lunch. There is no hustle or bustle today, the day is free to relax and enjoy yourself. If you love golf, the Island's golf course is just beautiful. Tonight we dine out at Barney Duffys, the best steak restaurant in town (2 course dinner). After dinner we are off to the Sound and Light Show at Kingston. Nightfall at

Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement. The stillness and the stars are just as they were before mankind arrived in 1788.

However, with the dramatic use of real life sounds, theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as we travel back to the early convict days.

**Day 7: Friday 11 March 2011
Greenfingers Tour
Night as a Convict**

Full buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning we join the Greenfingers Tour, a tour featuring some of the Island's loveliest gardens. Throughout the morning we visit a nursery owned and operated by a young Norfolk Islander, and view the hydroponics. We also visit a gorgeous private garden with spectacular views. Morning Tea is included at a scenic spot. Own arrangements for lunch, free afternoon. Our Night as a Convict is the most popular feature dinner on Norfolk - a fun night for all ages! We dress as a convict (outfits supplied) and join the Commandant for an evening of feasting, singing and dancing. Great food! Great fun!

**Day 8: Saturday 12 March 2011
Depart Norfolk Island**

Full buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, its time to pack our bags ready for our departure. There will be some time for last minute shopping and own lunch arrangements. We will be transferred to the airport to join our Norfolk Air flight departing Norfolk at 1420 to arrive in Sydney at 1540.
